



Manager of Regulatory and Market Affairs – ERCOT and SPP

POSITION

This position will be responsible for providing leadership and coordination around regulatory and market rule changes that will affect APM and its Members and Customers in the ERCOT and SPP markets. The position will provide guidance and facilitate analysis and reporting of the impacts of new and existing federal, state and regional energy regulations that impact the operations of APM and the portfolios of APM's Members and Customers. The role will require project management skills to coordinate resolutions and analysis among all APM staff and to effectively report and collaborate with Members and Customers. Furthermore, the position will provide leads for new clients to the new business development function of APM.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Candidate should possess a bachelor's degree in an appropriate discipline with extensive experience in the electric utility industry.
- Extensive knowledge of the Tariffs, Business Practices, and Market Protocols for the assigned Market or Regulatory Entity.
- Prefer 5 years direct experience with RTOs/ISOs and established power pools.
- Working knowledge of the mandatory reliability standards of the Electric Reliability Organization (ERO) and appropriate regional entities, as appropriate.
- Working knowledge of Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) and state commissions, as appropriate.
- Knowledge of the NAESB business practice standards development process (both electric and natural gas), as appropriate.
- Ability to understand and communicate technical concepts and their impact on member and customer portfolios.
- High degree of analytical skill.
- Effective written and oral communication skills as well as computer skills.
- Ability to coordinate and lead multiple parties to resolution through a disciplined project management approach.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide regulatory and market expertise to APM, and its Members and Customers, as required.
- Build and maintain applicable industry relationships to enable the ability to effectively communicate with ERCOT and SPP, and other regulatory bodies affected by ERCOT and SPP regulations.
- Monitor, analyze and communicate regulations, rules, policies, proposals, procedures, decisions, and standards and recommend effective business strategies to Members and Customers, as applicable.
- Participate in ISO/RTO stakeholder groups, task forces and committees, as well as, other industry groups to provide market intelligence to Members and Customers.
- Perform research of statutes, regulations, and rules in the review of positions and filings by Members and Customers, as requested.
- Provide APM's regional trading group's timely information and arrange training on rule changes that impact Member and Customer positions or operations.
- Provide timely reporting to Members and Customers, as applicable, of regulatory or market changes that impact them.
- Participate on APM Implementation Teams for new markets and market redesigns to ensure Member and Customer preparedness.
- Provide assistance in the development of corporate processes and operating procedures.
- Develop relationships with potential new clients and provide leads to the new business development function of APM.
- Will adhere to all APM corporate policies and comply with all APM regulatory requirements, including but not limited to NERC, FERC, and relevant state regulations, as applicable to this position
